



Educate and Elevate AmeriCorps

Join a passionate educational team and work with people from many different cultures and backgrounds! The Catherine McAuley Center is seeking an Educate and Elevate AmeriCorps member to join its Adult Basic Education Program. The AmeriCorps member will work directly with students, support volunteers, and play a role in developing and evaluating educational materials. This position works closely with staff and community members as it helps build the Center's capacity to provide hope and opportunity through educational services.

- Tutor adult learners who lack adult education and literacy skills and/or have not completed their high school diploma. Subject areas include basic reading, basic math, and/or English for speakers of other languages
- Assist with other student support services including intake, transcript evaluation, enrollment, completion of action plans, and orientation functions
- Support recruitment efforts by assisting with career pathway surveys and educational learning plans
- Engage in supplemental small group instruction such as the use of digital resources in a computer lab setting
- Support the development of online and independent learning opportunities for current or waitlisted students
- Strengthen small group, drop-in, and off-site programming, and assist in the continuing development of opportunities for the learning needs of those with emerging literacy

Qualifications:

- Must be high school graduate or have high school equivalency diploma
- Be at least 18 years of age at commencement of service
- Be a citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident alien of the United States
- Satisfy a 3-part criminal history background check

Benefits and Evaluation Requirements:

- Living allowance
- Education Award received upon successful completion of service term
- Student loan forbearance and interest payments, if member qualifies
- Member Performance Evaluation requirements during the term, if applicable
